Beyond October, get ready for the Fall Auction in November (along with elections) and the Club Christmas Party in December.

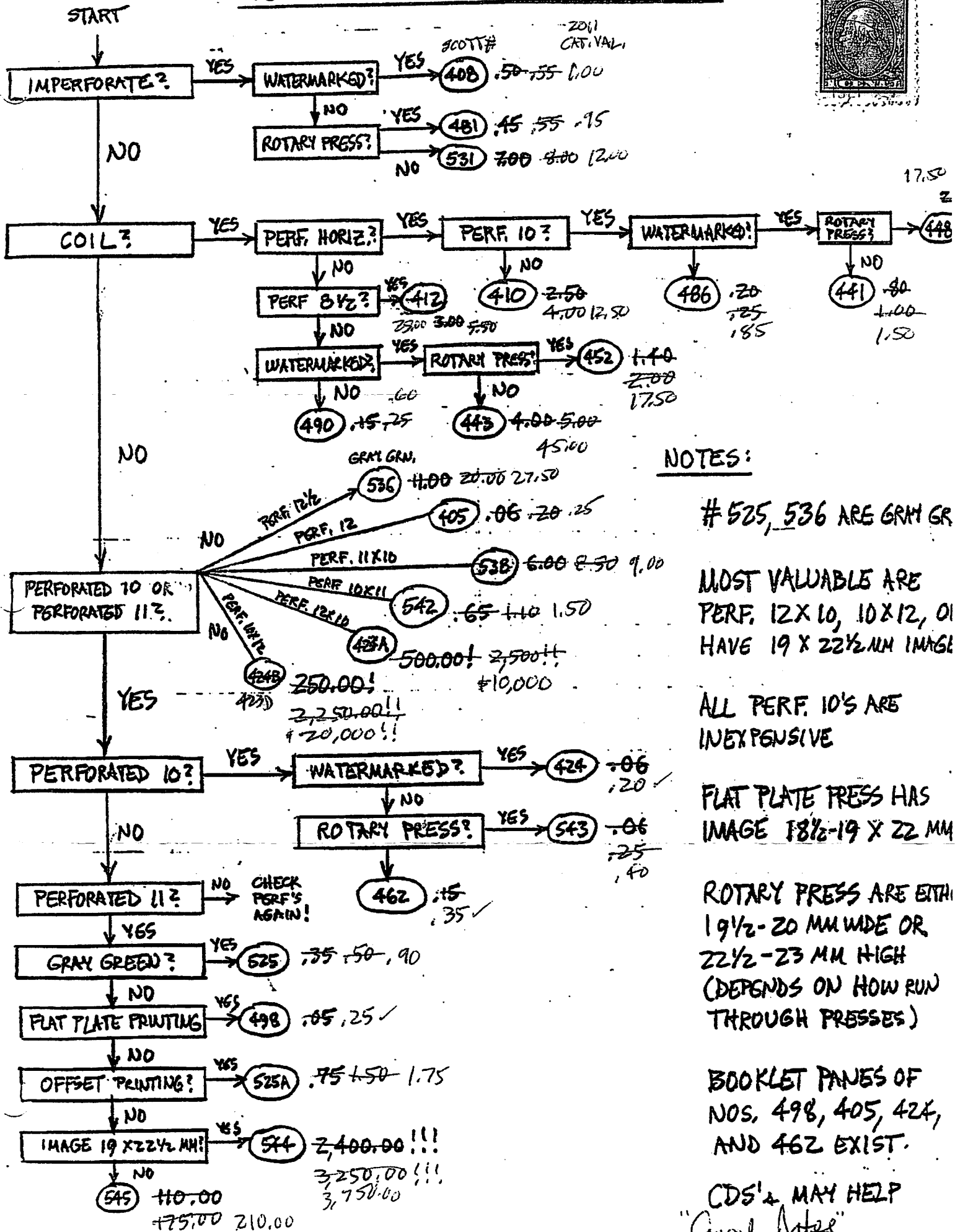
Got Duplicates?
